INTEPLAST ANNOUNCES \$12 MILLION DOLLAR INVESTMENT TO INCREASE BOPP FILM CAPACITY

Livingston, NJ—Inteplast Group announces that its AmTopp Division will increase existing bi-axially oriented polypropylene (BOPP) film manufacturing capacity by 25%, to a total of 300 million pounds annually. This will be accomplished through an extensive de-bottle necking project on its existing extrusion lines in the Lolita, Texas, plant.

The \$12 million dollar investment will focus on major equipment modifications and improvements to increase not only the film output but also the film quality.

AmTopp is a leading supplier of BOPP films in North America. These films are currently being used in a variety of product applications in the packaging, tape, and labeling markets. The announced investment seeks to better serve its customer base.

Homer Hsieh, President of AmTopp, said, “We are humbled to have gained wide customer acceptance to our films. This is the result of a total team effort that has produced focus and commitment to our customers’ concerns. This investment is necessary for us to quickly attend to our customers’ immediate needs, given the current tight supply situation.”

This multi-stage investment, scheduled for completion by the fourth quarter of 2008, is already underway and capacity will increase gradually at the end of each stage.
